As per the subject cited, and in continuation of TMREIS initiatives to enhance student preparedness for competitive government job recruitment examinations, it has been decided to conduct a Pilot Coaching Program in collaboration with the Zakat Foundation of India.

- The coaching will be conducted online by the Zakat Foundation of India.
- Session will be held thrice in a week Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 11:30 AM to 12:30 PM.
- The regular class that is missed during this time must be compensated in the evening study hour.
- Regular classes should not be affected in any manner.
- Any disturbance caused due to the coaching must be compensated without fail.

 The implementation will be monitored by Academic Coordinators, who shall ensure strict compliance.

 They are required to submit reports on attendance, student progress, and challenges faced during the coaching.

All Principals must submit a weekly progress report to the Academic Team.

 Any deviations or concerns must be escalated immediately to the Head Office for timely resolution.

This program is a priority initiative of TMREIS to prepare students for competitive government job opportunities. All concerned are hereby instructed to ensure strict compliance, and make necessary arrangements for the effective conduct of the coaching sessions.
